

# NEW YORK DISTRICT GWRRA REGION B

## 2010 DASH FOR CASH RULES

*(Only Chapters assigned to the NY District can compete in the 2010 Dash for Cash Program)*

New York District GWRRA “Dash for Cash” is entering its third year, with the previous years being quite successful all around. The purpose and focus of the program remains the same as it has from its inception - to encourage our Chapters to visit each other, participate in chapter events and attend Rallies and other functions in and around our district.

As in the past, the New York District will pay the charter fee for the year 2011 for any chapter that attains the required 20 points. The points will be acquired during the program, which will run from January 1, 2010 through November 15, 2010. The Chapter with the most points in excess of 20 at the end of the program will also be awarded a check for \$100.00.

Chapters will earn points by visiting other chapters and participating in other chapters’ events. Events and meetings/gatherings are defined on the next page. Chapters that can be visited to gain points also include the neighboring states of Vermont, Ohio, Massachusetts, Connecticut, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Ontario, Canada.

Included in ways to earn points are any district approved and scheduled ride-in or opening ride, any ride-out or closing ride, as well as any district-sponsored event or get together. Points can also be earned by attending the GWRRA Americade District Breakfast, and any Ride for Kids Event.

*(Only Chapters assigned to the NY District can compete in the 2010 Dash for Cash Program)*

**Rules:**

- A minimum of 6 Card-Carrying GWRRA Members must attend to qualify for points.
- Each chapter must visit at least one chapter and attend one chapter event to qualify for the program. (\*\*Strongly urged to attend the Bi-State Rally)
- Each chapter can earn a maximum of 5 points from any one Chapter. (1 Mtg per chapter + 2 Activity / Event = 5 Points) and a maximum of one Ride for Kids Event
- Hosting a District Event must be approved and will be at the discretion of the District Director or Assistant Director.
- The New York District Directors are not eligible to be counted in a chapter's six card-carrying members. The balance of the New York District staff are eligible to be counted and are expected to participate in the program to the fullest extent possible.

**Points:**

- Chapter Gathering/Meeting 1
- Chapter Event 2
- COY Chapter Couple 2
- NY-NJ Bi-State Rally/Convention 3
- District Event other than Convention 1
- Host a District Event 2
- Other District Rally or event within Region B 2
- District Rally or event outside Region B 1
- Wing Ding 3
- Ride for Kids Participation 1
- RFK GWRRA Top 5 Fund Raiser 1
- RFK GWRRA Top Fund Raiser 1

**Ride for Kids Qualification:**

- Any Chapter who attends a Ride for Kids Celebration of Life Event w/ 6 GWRRA Members and Donates will receive 1 point.
- Chapters will register GWRRA NY as their Club Affiliation
- If GWRRA NY is one of the Top 5 Donations for the event, each chapter in attendance will receive 1 point.
- If GWRRA NY is the top Donation for the entire event then each chapter in attendance will receive 1 point.

**Definitions:**

- Chapter Meeting /Gathering is defined as a regularly scheduled monthly meeting as published in the chapter newsletter or website.
- Chapter Event is defined as a special get together open to all chapters and advertised in the Chapter Newsletter and/or Website.
- COY Participant is defined as having a Chapter COY on record with the NY District.
- Other Region B Rally is listed and published in the Region Newsletter and Website as of May 1, 2010.

**Disclaimers and Legal Stuff:**

- All points need to be approved by Suzette Wood with a picture and particulars of date, time, members in attendance & GWRRA officer verifying attendance.
- Any and all disputes, ties or discrepancies will be decided by the NY District Director and Assistant Director.
- The New York District Director reserves the sole right to modify, suspend, or discontinue the program for any reason at any time during the length of the program.
